Key Things to Consider Before Installing a Skylight

Roof pitch and orientation

The angle and direction of your roof play a major role in how effective a skylight will be. A steeper roof pitch may require a different skylight model or flashing system, while orientation (north, south, east, or west-facing) affects how much sunlight enters your space throughout the day. For example, north-facing skylights provide consistent, soft light, while west-facing ones bring in stronger afternoon sun—great in winter but potentially overheating in summer.

Best placement for light and airflow

Strategic skylight placement can dramatically enhance both lighting and ventilation. Consider which rooms need a natural light boost or improved air circulation. Placing a ventilating skylight high in the ceiling can help hot air escape more efficiently, while positioning it above frequently used spaces like kitchens or bathrooms ensures both comfort and functionality.

Skylight sizing guide

Size matters when it comes to skylights. A general rule of thumb is that the skylight area should be no more than 5–10% of the floor area of the room. Larger skylights bring in more light but may also increase solar heat gain. Choosing the right size depends on room dimensions, ceiling height, and how much natural light you want to introduce without overwhelming the space. The spacing of your trusses will also play a role here.


